1. What is the important information for international students?

2. How do I register as a student after I have accepted the offer of admission?

3. How do I apply for Student's Card ID?

Details relevant to President University students, in particular, are available in the Office of Admission. Please be reminded that you must have all the required documents for the application to be processed. Your application will not be processed if any of the above documents are not submitted.

4. What are the consequences if I do not complete registration?

If you do not complete Registration, you are deemed to have withdrawn your acceptance of the offer of admission. The University reserves the right to revoke the offer and grant the vacancy to other applicants on the waiting list.

5. How do I obtain a student visa to enter Indonesia?

- All international students must have a valid visa to enter Indonesia. We suggest student to get the student visa.
- The process to obtain this immigration document will take about 60-90 days. This is due to international student should obtain a STUDY PERMIT (from the Ministry of Research, Technology & Higher Education in Indonesia) and TELEX VISA (from the Immigration Headquarter in Jakarta) before applying for student visa at the Indonesian Embassy in your home country or residences.
- The immigration process of obtaining **STUDY PERMIT** and **TELEX VISA** can be complicated, yet the international office of President University will apply for the entry on your behalf, and to appoint a document handling agent to process your immigration documents with student's expenses.
- Please be advised that these immigration process can only be started after receiving the Letter of Acceptance [LoA].

6. Are international students coming to president university required to undergo medical examination?

- All international students who plan to stay and study full-time at President University are required by the Ministry of Health
 of Republic of Indonesia to undergo and pass the medical examination.
- Students who are found to have active Tuberculosis or HIV infection and or NAPZA of Narcotics drugs will not be granted the Student's Pass, and will have to return to their home country at their own expense.
- The pre-admission medical examination is mandatory for all successful applicants admitted to undergraduate program, regardless of whether they are Indonesia local or international students.
- International students may choose to undergo a single medical examination that fulfils the requirements medical examinations. This service is available at the President Medical Center [PMC]. Please visit PMC website for more details.
- For more details on the medical examination for international student, please refer to the Head Student Affair at President University.

3. I was given a late offer and could only confirm my acceptance after the deadline of registration. What should I do?

To register, students must first make an online acceptance of President University's offer of admission. If you have not made the online acceptance, please do so immediately and allow 5 [five] working days before logging in to the Registration System again.
