Full English as a medium of communication

All incoming Freshmen joining the President University will undergo a TOEIC (Test of English International Communication) Mapping Reading and Listening Test upon arrival. This test will assess the students' English proficiency in relation to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) standard of which President University has indicated to be 405.

If the student's TOEIC score falls below 405, then the student is required to undergo the English Supplemental Program (ESP) that the Professional Development Center (PDC) organizes every year to help students improve their English proficiency and bring it up to the desired CEFR standard.

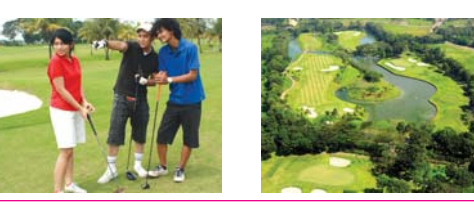
PRESIDENT UNIVERSITY GOLF

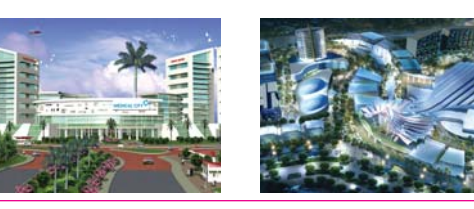

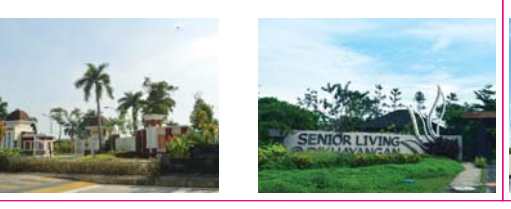
